## **BOSTON CHURCH PLANT** | [boston339.com](http://boston339.com)

September 21-25 | \$1,250 – \$1,450

Chris Causey, a church planter trained and sent by Pinelake, is planting a community of believers, Encounter Church, in Boston. This city has been described as one of the most difficult places to plant a church in the US. Teams will work with Encounter in various community outreach and service projects, prayer walking and preparation for worship services.

Haiti teams will provide medical and dental treatment for individuals living in remote areas, as well as other opportunities for Haitians to hear the Gospel and connect with local churches.
